Maine GIS User Group – Angela Stokes Scholarship

Purpose:

The purpose of the scholarship program is to encourage and support students to undertake and complete commendable GIS projects. The scholarship is a memorial to Angela Stokes, a previous winner of this scholarship who passed away February 1st, 2006.

Maine GIS User Group (MEGUG) hopes to make one \$1,000 scholarship award annually available to any qualifying Maine college or university undergraduate students.

Requirements for receiving a scholarship:

- The applicant must be enrolled in a Maine college or university and have completed at least one semester of undergraduate study at the time of application submission.
- The applicant must submit a completed application.
- The applicant must complete the proposed work within 1 year of the award date.
- The applicant must present their work at a MEGUG-sponsored meeting within six months from the end of the project.
- MEGUG will be given permission to use the resulting project materials, copies of the materials, or make reference to materials, to promote the scholarship program and to advance the mission of MEGUG. Actual ownership of resulting materials will remain with the successful applicant and or school.
- MEGUG requires that ownership of any purchases (equipment, data, etc.) be transferred to the host school for use by other students.

Please note that MEGUG Board members and their family members are ineligible to apply.

Preference will be given to projects based in the State of Maine.

Deadline:

The deadline for submitting a completed application is March 30, 2017. Applications and scoring criteria are available at the MEGUG website: www.megug.org/education-outreach/

Evaluation:

The MEGUG Scholarship Committee will evaluate and score all applications based on the information provided by the applicant and make recommendations to the MEGUG Board.

Review and scoring will occur in April 2017. The MEGUG Board will select the award

recipient. The Board reserves the right to not award any scholarships. Announcement of the award is anticipated for May 1, 2017 at the latest. Disbursement schedule is at the Board's discretion.

Submitting Applications:

This document is a writable pdf form that must be completed and submitted with all supporting documents. Applicants using a desktop email application (e.g. Outlook, Eudora or Thunderbird) will automatically have the completed form added as an attached to a blank email after clicking the 'Submit' button at the end of the form. Applicants using an Internet email service (e.g. Yahoo, Gmail or Hotmail) will be prompted to save the completed form after clicking the 'Submit' button at the end of the form and will need to send it manually as an attachment to:

MEGUG - Angela Stokes Scholarship Application Guidelines

Please complete the following **MEGUG – Angela Stokes Scholarship Application Form** and submit with the following items:

1. **Description of the project** – limit of 2 pages. Please include:
 - A statement of the research or project questions and objectives.
 - A description of the method(s) planned to accomplish the objectives, the significance of the research or project.
 - A work plan including a time line for the project and how the funds will be used.
2. **Personal statement** – Limit to 1 page. Please describe your current educational goals and interests related to GIS, including why you chose to apply to this program. Please also explain your reasoning in choosing your field of study, along with how your professional ambitions and career goals relate to GIS.
3. **A letter of recommendation**. A letter must be from a teacher, faculty member, or other person who can speak in detail about your project. Others can speak to your character, academic achievements, and practical experience with GIS, and extracurricular activities. If one chooses to provide more than one letter of support, that is also encouraged.
4. **Proof of Enrollment** A copy of your current class schedule or an unofficial transcript.
